Jean M. Bell moved to approve the Treasurer's Quarterly Report as printed. Steve George seconded the motion which carried with a 5-0 vote.


Steve George moved to approve the 2015 Liquor License for Wing's Spirits. Jeff Parsons seconded the motion which carried with a 5-0 vote.



FIFTH AVE., HILL CITY, KANSAS, IS UNSAFE OR DANGEROUS AND DIRECTING THAT THE STRUCTURE BE REMOVED AND THE PREMISES MADE SAFE AND SECURE." Jean M.
